## **RE: WARINGSTOWN VINTAGE CAVALCADE - FRIDAY, 28 JUNE 2019**

### **TIMINGS**

Horsedrawn vehicle owners will be advised of assembly point, time 6.00 pm.  
ALL other vehicles are to assemble on the Banbridge side of the village from 6.00 pm - 7.00 pm. To allow the Parade to start on time vehicle owners should **NOT ATTEMPT** to drive through Waringstown after 6.45 pm. Diversions will be in operation and signposted. All tractor entrants going to tea in the Parochial Hall on the return journey should turn left up Mill Hill to the parking area. **DRIVERS AND VEHICLES MUST COMPLY WITH THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, INCLUDING WEARING OF CRASH HELMETS BY MOTOR CYCLISTS. NO UNDER AGE DRIVERS OR UNDER AGE PASSENGERS ALLOWED ON MOTOR CYCLES OR TRACTORS. THIS RULING WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED BY P.S.N.I.**
